



## MaxiFrame Quick Start Guide

- Install MaxiFrame in your Applications folder and launch the application.
- From the File menu, select the type of playlist to create. Standard playlist contain a clip list that you create and modify. Dynamic playlist contain clips loaded from a folder that you supply.
- The Movies Source Pane is on the left of the window. The table in the Movie Source Pane represents the playback order for clips in your playlist. You may arrange them using drag'n'drop.
- Below the Movies Source Pane are a set of panes for adjusting playback attributes, such as playback speed, looping, and the destination screen for playback.
- To the right of the main window is a preview movie. The playback controls are located immediately underneath the preview movie.

### **For a Standard playlist:**

- To add movies, click the “Add Movie” button on the toolbar or select the similarly named option on the File Menu. You may also drag clips from the Finder onto the MaxiFrame document window.
- To remove a clip, select it and press the delete key.

### **For a Dynamic Playlist:**

- When creating a Dynamic playlist, MaxiFrame ask for a folder to use as the clip source. Once MaxiFrame loads the list of clips, the Playlist contents can not be changed (although the order may be changed with drag'n'drop).
- To load clips from another folder, click the “Set Source Folder” icon on the toolbar.
